BY-LAWS

Office Hours Monday to Friday, 9:30 am to 11:30 am, 1:30 p.m. To 5:00 pm
Visitors are welcome from 9:00 am to Sundown
Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult, who shall be responsible for their good conduct
Vehicles within the Cemetery shall not exceed 20 km per hour and shall not leave the roads. Vehicle owners are responsible for any damage they incur.
Dogs are permitted, on a leash and under control of the owner.

LOCATION OF VASES,
MONUMENTS ETC. The Company reserves the right to determine the location of all vases, flower beds, monuments, markers, new planting, etc. , in the Cemetery.

ALL THE WORK TO BE
DONE BY THE CEMETERY
COMPANY In order that the Cemetery may be kept in uniformly good order, and to protect the grounds from injury by irresponsible workmen, all work of every description within the Cemetery, except that of placing monuments on foundations and the erection of vaults, shall be done by the Cemetery staff.

REMOVAL OF PLANTS,
FLOWERS, ETC Vases and Flower Beds are required to be cleared of all tender plants by the first frost in the Fall. Interment Rights Holders desiring to take any plants away should do so before September 15th. To insure that there is no unauthorized interference with the flowers or decoration upon the graves or elsewhere in the Cemetery, it is necessary to procure permission at the Cemetery office before removing flowers, plants, ribbons or other articles from plots or graves.

GLASS, IRONWORK,
ETC. No article made of glass, cellophane, or in the nature of wire or wooden trellis, wooden crosses, boxes or arches, etc. shall be placed on plots or graves. Where there is no flower bed, a hanging basket is permitted. However, the Cemetery accepts no responsibility for such.

RUBBISH PROHIBITED	Rubbish shall not be thrown on roads, walks or any part of the grounds. Receptacles are provided at convenient points on the grounds for the deposit of weeds, decayed flowers, plants, etc.
MOVING OF MARKERS	The moving of markers is limited to Cemetery employees.
ARTIFICIAL WREATHS	During the growing season, April 15th to November 1st, while natural flowers are available, artificial flowers in the form of wreaths, or in any other form, are not permitted on graves or plots.
REMOVAL OF ARTIFICIAL WREATHS	To preserve the proper appearance of the grounds, artificial wreaths must be removed by April 15th of each year, otherwise the Cemetery authorities will remove them.
COMPANY NOT RESPONSIBLE	The Company shall take reasonable precautions to protect the property of the Interment Rights Holders but assume no responsibility or liability for loss of, or damage to, any monument, vault, marker or part thereof or any article of any type whatsoever that may be placed on any plot or grave.
PLANTING OF FLOWER BEDS, TREES AND SHRUBS	Flower beds are permitted in front of monuments in a space reserved for them. Where no monument exists, flower beds are not permitted. Permission must be obtained from the Caretaker before planting ornamental trees or shrubs, and once planted, these become the property of the Cemetery.
PURCHASE OF MONUMENTS	Not more than one monument shall be erected on any lot or smaller subdivision and this must be placed in space reserved for it. The Board reserves the right to determine the maximum size of the monument and the location on the lot. Interment Right Holders are cautioned, and this is very important, not to close any monument purchase or other structure to be erected or placed on any lot until its design, plans and specifications relative to the material and construction thereof shall have been submitted to and approved by the Caretaker.
